

PROCEDURE FOR:  
MODIFICATION OR TERMINATION OF A “**NO CONTACT ORDER**”  
FOR THE BAINBRIDGE ISLAND MUNICIPAL COURT

**STEP 1:**

- **It is recommended that the named victim of the criminal case speak with the Domestic Violence advocate.** This is a service that is free of charge.
- **Call the YWCA of Kitsap County** at 360-479-0491 or 1-800-500-5513 or legaladvocacy@ywcakitsap.org to schedule an appointment with the Domestic Violence Advocate.
- **Identify yourself**, provide the **name of the person** against whom the No Contact Order has been filed, and **the court case number** if known.
- **You should receive an appointment** within one week or sooner.

**STEP 2:**

- Speak personally with the Domestic Violence Advocate prior to the hearing.
- **The Domestic Violence Advocate will talk with you regarding safety issues & community resources.**

**STEP 3:**

- **Submit the “Motion to Modify/Terminate No Contact Order and Notice of Hearing” form to Municipal Court office (in person, scan and email, or fax)**
- **A hearing date** will be set by the clerk.
- **You must appear** for the hearing in order for the Court to consider your request to dismiss/ modify the No Contact Order. You may appear via the Zoom platform.
- Contact with the DV Advocate is one factor the court will consider with your request. The Judge will consider your written request. You may also speak to the Judge at the hearing.
