




Calls for Service Averages from 2016 through 2020 YTD Aug









Crimes Against Persons: Includes Murder, Forcible Sex Offenses, Robbery, Aggravated or Simple Assault, Intimidation, Non-Forcible Sex Offenses, Kidnapping, Human Trafficking, Violation of No Contact Order






