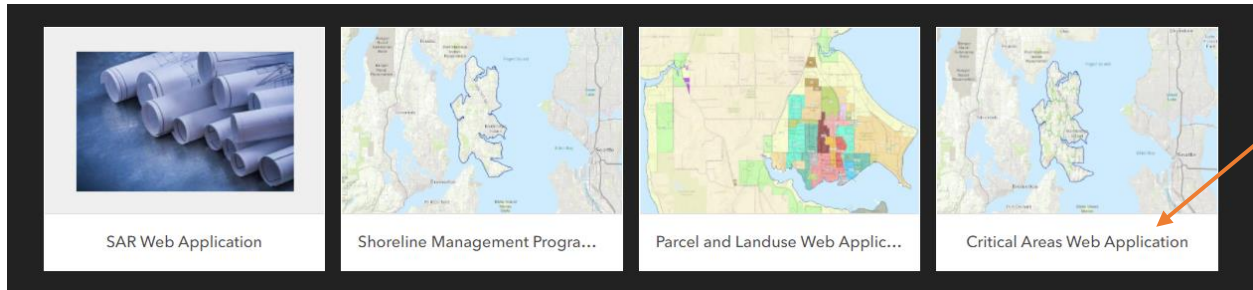
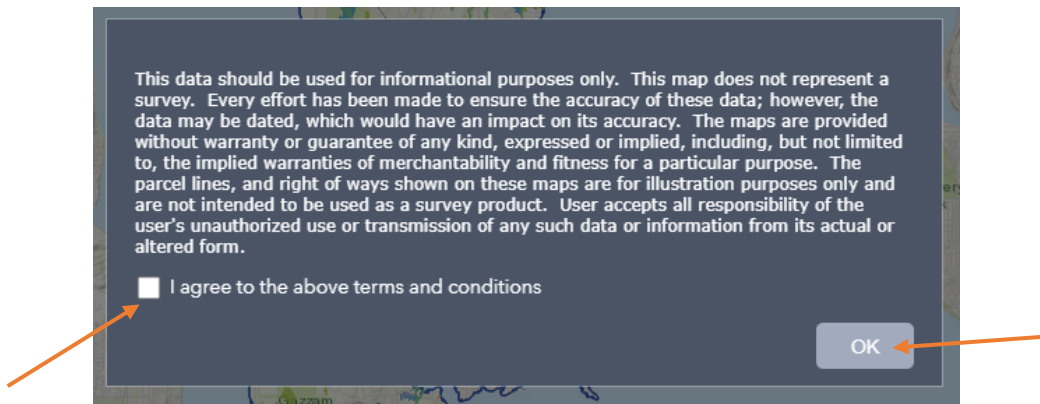


GIS Mapping Tool

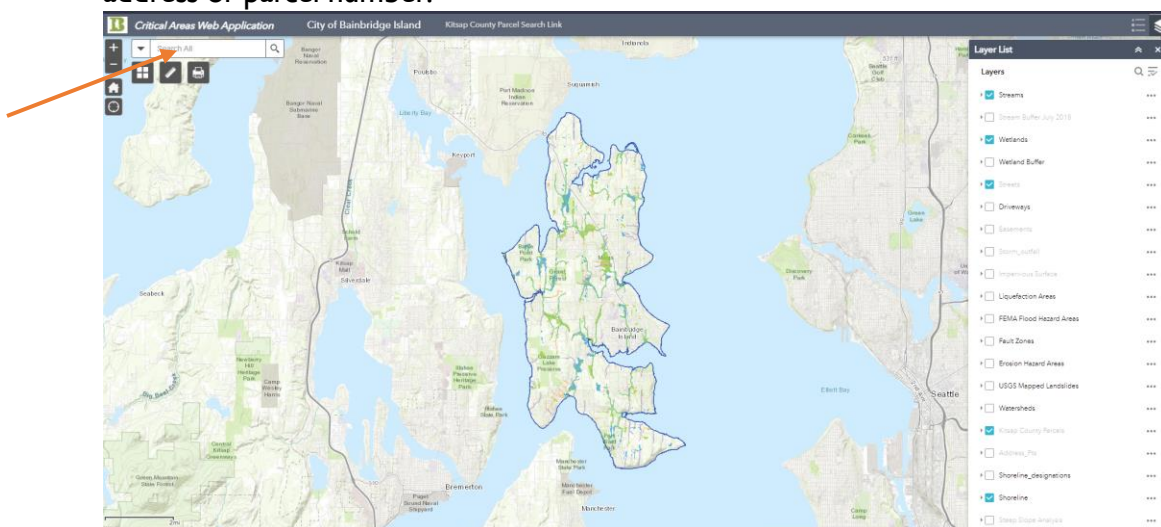
1. Once you are on our mapping page, click on the Critical Areas Web Application map.



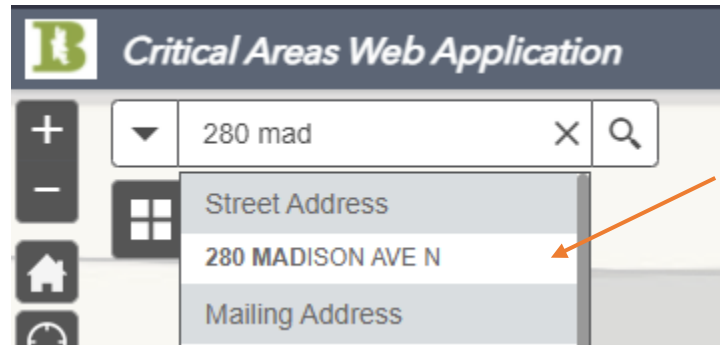
2. Once you've read the terms and conditions, click the box to agree, then click OK



3. In the upper left-hand corner of the screen, you will see a search bar. Enter either an address or parcel number.



- Once you start to type, the search will look for possible matches. Click on the address or parcel you wish to see.



- On the right-hand side, you will see a Layer List. There are several layers already selected. A few important ones you will also want to select are:
 - Stream Buffer July 2018
 - Wetland Buffer
 - FEMA Flood Hazard Areas
 - Erosion Hazard Areas
 - USGS Mapped Landslides
 - Shoreline designations
 - Steep Slope Analysis

Helpful tip: Try looking at layers individually or turning various layer on and off. Sometimes, with the overlapping colors, it can be hard to distinguish between the various layers.



To know what each color means click on the arrow next to the layer to expand it and the legend will describe what each color means.
