PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on October 11, 2022, the Hearing Examiner issued a decision, with conditions, approving Tom White’s application for a Reasonable Use Exception (RUE) and a Zoning Variance, related to property at 3935 Lytle Road NE (Nos. PLN51498 RUE and PLN51498 VAR). On October 24, 2022, Attorney James Haney, on behalf of the City of Bainbridge Island (City), filed a Request for Reconsideration of the Hearing Examiner’s decision. The following day, Attorney Joshua Lane, on behalf of Astolfo Rueda, also filed a Request for Reconsideration.

Section 1.9.5 of the Hearing Examiner’s Rules of Procedure provides:

The Hearing Examiner shall respond to the request for reconsideration . . . by affirming in writing the previous decision, reopening the record and hearing process, or taking further action as appropriate. Prior to granting a request for reconsideration, the Hearing Examiner may request a response from all parties of record.
