What is the Road Preservation Program?

- ▶ **Asphalt Repairs** consist of full-depth patches of deteriorated pavement or failed road base, including pulverizing existing road surface, grading, and paving.

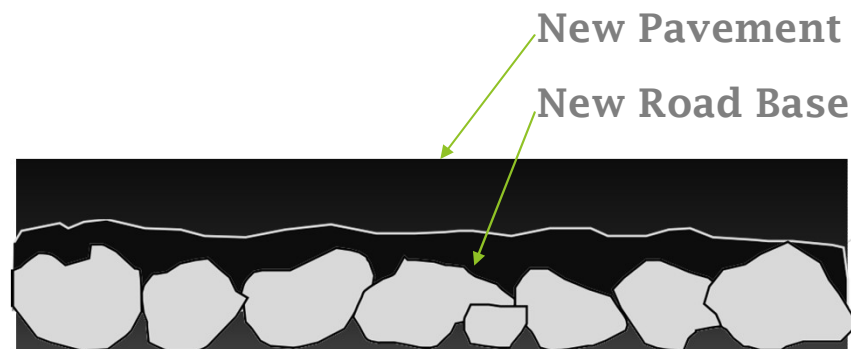
How are the roads preserved?



COBI will preserve Country Club Road from Toe Jam to 11162 NE Country Club Road through repaving and grading at the direction of the projects geotechnical engineer Aspect and the design engineer OTAK.

What does full road repair do?

Asphalt full depth repair is a method where sections of existing road are excavated and repaved. This helps to fix areas of cracking, gaps in the asphalt or potholes. This method is great in areas where the overall road is in very poor condition with base failure. In areas where below the base has failed with the Geotechnical Engineers design guidance additional excavation will occur.



What should I expect?

Once a contractor has been accepted and approved by City Council the contractor will provide the city with their planned work schedule. This schedule will be updated to the website at that time.

What do I need to do?

Avoid outdoor water use if it causes water to flow onto the street.
Please make sure the water does not flow onto the street during any pavement repair activity.

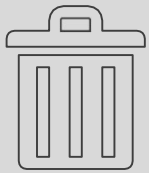


Remove all vehicles and other objects from the street.
This includes trailers, garbage cans, basketball hoops, etc. Please keep these removed for the full extent of the roads program. There are times when the contractor may have to come back at different stages of the project. COBI will send out a listserv when the project is substantially complete.



What if there is an emergency?

Should an emergency arise, emergency vehicles will be given access to the street.

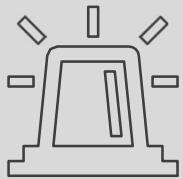




What if it rains?

Light rain or passing showers may not delay the road repair project.

If we have or anticipate significant rainfall, the pavement repair project may be postponed to another day. You will be notified of the new application date via the city website and/or signs along your street. Please check the website frequently and look out for street signage.



What if I need to drive somewhere?

If you must drive during posted closures, park your vehicle on a nearby street that is not included in the project. Check area signage to help plan your route and determine where to park. If you are concerned about getting to an appointment make a plan, be prepared. Expect that there will be delays and challenges accessing the road, so you can be fully prepared.



What about garbage pickup, mail delivery, etc.?

- ▶ Road projects are coordinated with the Postal Service, garbage haulers and other service providers. In most cases, you will not experience any service interruptions.
- ▶ Put garbage cans out early on your regular collection day, preferably at the edge of your driveway rather than in the street.

Garbage haulers and mail carriers will work around the pavement repair project to provide service— although it may not be at the usual time of day.

Scheduling and Access Impacts-During Road Surface Removal and Regrading Phase of Construction

The impacts during this phase of work will be updated based on the contractors plans and schedule. The city will work with the contractor to find a balance between getting the work done and limiting impact on users of the road during construction. We thank you for your patience during this project and work to get it completed as quickly as possible. Construction tends to take longer than expected and unforeseeable things happen, so thank you to our citizen for their kindness to the workers and flaggers who are working hard to repair a section of road that many citizens have stated the need for repair of.

Scheduling and Access Impacts-During Paving Phase of Construction

A few days prior to the application of pavement, the Contractor will place on-site notices to move your vehicles from the roadway.

Rather than leave your vehicle in the driveway, it's advised to move your vehicle over to a neighboring road if you intend to leave for work, appointments, etc.

This work cannot be rescheduled due to an events that residents may have previously planned; therefore, residents should ask their guests to park on neighboring streets to accommodate the project.

During paving, the crews work closely with the police. The only exception for vehicles using the road would be given during an emergency event.

Paving typically occurs between the hours of 7 AM to 7 PM Monday thru Friday.
