CITY COUNCIL SEEKS APPLICANTS FOR NEWLY CREATED CLIMATE CHANGE
ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Bainbridge Island, Wash., (May, 2017) – The Bainbridge Island City Council is seeking seven qualified applicants for the newly created Climate Change Advisory Committee.

The newly formed committee will advise the City Council, City Manager, and department of Planning and Community Development staff on issues related to climate change. The committee will also assist the City in implementing the climate related goals and policies of the Comprehensive Plan including completing a greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory for the city, recommending a GHG emission reduction target, and developing a climate action plan and implementation strategy.

Applications are available [online](#) and must be submitted by close of business on Friday, June 9. Applicants should have expertise in climate science or atmospheric science or have expertise in the relationship between climate change and engineering, energy management, water conservation, planning, policy, environmental law, economics, solid waste management, forestry, systems analysis, and communications. Members of the committee shall serve for a period of three years.
